Please wear a face covering at all times when you are in the museum and shop for your safety and that of others.



Please follow the one-way system as set out on the floorplan. There are a couple of areas on each floor where passing places make 2 metre social distancing difficult. Please pause and wait for others to pass.



The number of visitors has been reduced through pre-booking so that social distancing can be maintained. You are welcome to stay as long as you like.



Please observe 2 metre social distancing throughout the building.

Customer toilets and hand washing facilities are located on the ground floor at the end of the Settlement Gallery and by Sir William Harpur Gallery and on the first floor in the Harpur Studio. All toilets are operating on a one in, one out system.



Hand sanitiser is available at the entrance, exit and in toilet areas.



The frequency of cleaning touch points and toilets has been increased and will take place throughout the day.
